How we calculate your results

This report is based on the <u>daily attendance data</u> your school shares with the Department for Education (DfE). It comes from your school's management information system (MIS) and is updated twice daily (morning and afternoon).

Your results are based on attendance and absence data for the first half of the autumn term in the 2024 to 2025 academic year. It includes data from the start of the academic year 2024 to 2025 up to Monday 04 November 2024 for your pupils in years 7 to 11. We do not include any changes you make to pupil data in your MIS after this date.

Data in this report may be different from data in your MIS, official statistics and other attendance data tools. Other attendance data reports may be updated daily, termly or cover an entire academic year or the academic year-to-date. This can cause large differences in the number of persistently absent pupils.

Refer to the data definitions to understand how we calculate attendance.

Pupil characteristics data

Results for pupils with special education needs (SEN) support and free school meals (FSM) are taken from the latest record available in your MIS in the current academic year. Previous academic year results are calculated based on pupil characteristics records from the previous year.

Pupils with SEN support are pupils with SEN support or an education health and care plan (EHCP).

Pupil characteristic records that are 'unknown' are taken to mean the pupil does not have the relevant characteristic.

National average

The national averages in this report are for pupils in years 7 to 11 in mainstream secondary schools in England. Other statistics may cover different time periods or schools or year groups.



Overall attendance and persistent absence percentage for your school compared to the national average from the start of the autumn term 2024 to 2025, up to Monday 04 November 2024.




Overall attendance is 87.2% which is 1.8% less than the national average. Persistent absence is 27.8% which is 2.8% greater than the national average.

Compare school attendance with national data


